
Partnering with American Dance Leadership

American Dance Leadership held it's first Leadership Conference on November 7-9, 2025 at the Proscenium Theatre, Pima Community College West, Tucson, Arizona where 31 young ambassadors attended dance masterclasses and leadership lectures. ADL's jury included dance education from Travis Bertell, Brandon Coleman, Naomi Funaki, and Maya Taylor. Leadership lectures were taught by Cleartalent Agent Kaila Cassling and Professor Joseph Berriman J.D. from the University of Arizona. Two scholarships for the 2026 conferences were given to Javin Lopez (Flowing Wells High School), and Mila Capazzi (Empire High School). A \$1,000 College Scholarship was also awarded to Evelyn Nagle (Tanque Verde High School).
